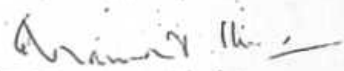

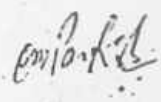

The Bank account shall be operated by the Treasurer with counter signature of the President of the Mahasabha.

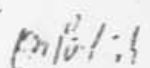
16. Legal Proceeding (Section 6 of the Act):

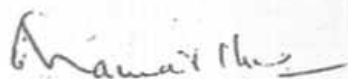
(b) **General Secretary:** He shall carry out the instructions of the President, to convene the meetings. He shall issue agenda and write minutes of the proceedings of the meetings. He may nominate two joint Secretary or two members only. He shall be the custodian of the records of the Mahasabha, exercise all his duties to control and supervise the working of the committee, shall appoint, dismiss or suspend any salaried or non-salaried officers with the consent of the President. 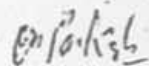

The Treasurer shall operate the accounts of the Mahasabha. The Treasurer shall keep the accounts properly and as per instruction of the Mahasabha and shall place the statement of accounts and balance sheet before the Governing Body duly audited by the Auditor appointed by the General Body / president.

9. Powers and Functions of the Governing Body:

N.B. No quorum shall be required for the adjourned meeting.

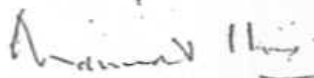

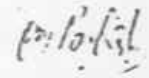
10. Power and duties of office bearers:

N.B. No quorum shall be required for the adjourned meetings.

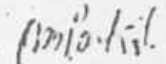

1. **Membership:** A person who has completed 18 years of age and who will abide the rules and regulations of the Mahasabha can become a Member.
2. **Admission & Qualification:** A person who has completed 18 year of age and has a good moral character can become a Member and obeys the constitution of the Mahasabha.
3. **Admission:** Admission / subscription Fee Rs. 2/- per year payable on or before 31st March of each year.

(a) Patron shall pay Rs. 1100/-

(b) Sympathizer shall pay Rs. 501/-

(c) Well-wisher shall pay Rs. 101/-

(d) Member shall pay Rs. 11/- per year on or before 31st March of each year.

4. **Removal of Members/Office Bearers :** A person shall be removed from the membership:

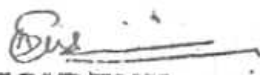
(a) If he or she committed moral turpitude or of unsound mind.

(b) If his or her misbehavior is found injurious to the interest of the Mahasabha.

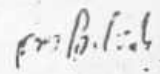
(c) If he or she failed to pay subscription up to 3 months from the due date.

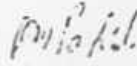

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- (25) To undertake road safety programmes, and to help police and or traffic police and or traffic police to control the vehicles and social -- evils on the road.

- (9) To support the Indian citizens, particularly members of minority community i.e. men, women, and others to enjoy basic civil liberties and fundamental rights.


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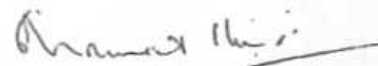

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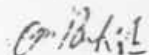

1. (a) Name of the Society: The name of the society shall be

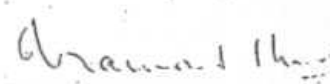
