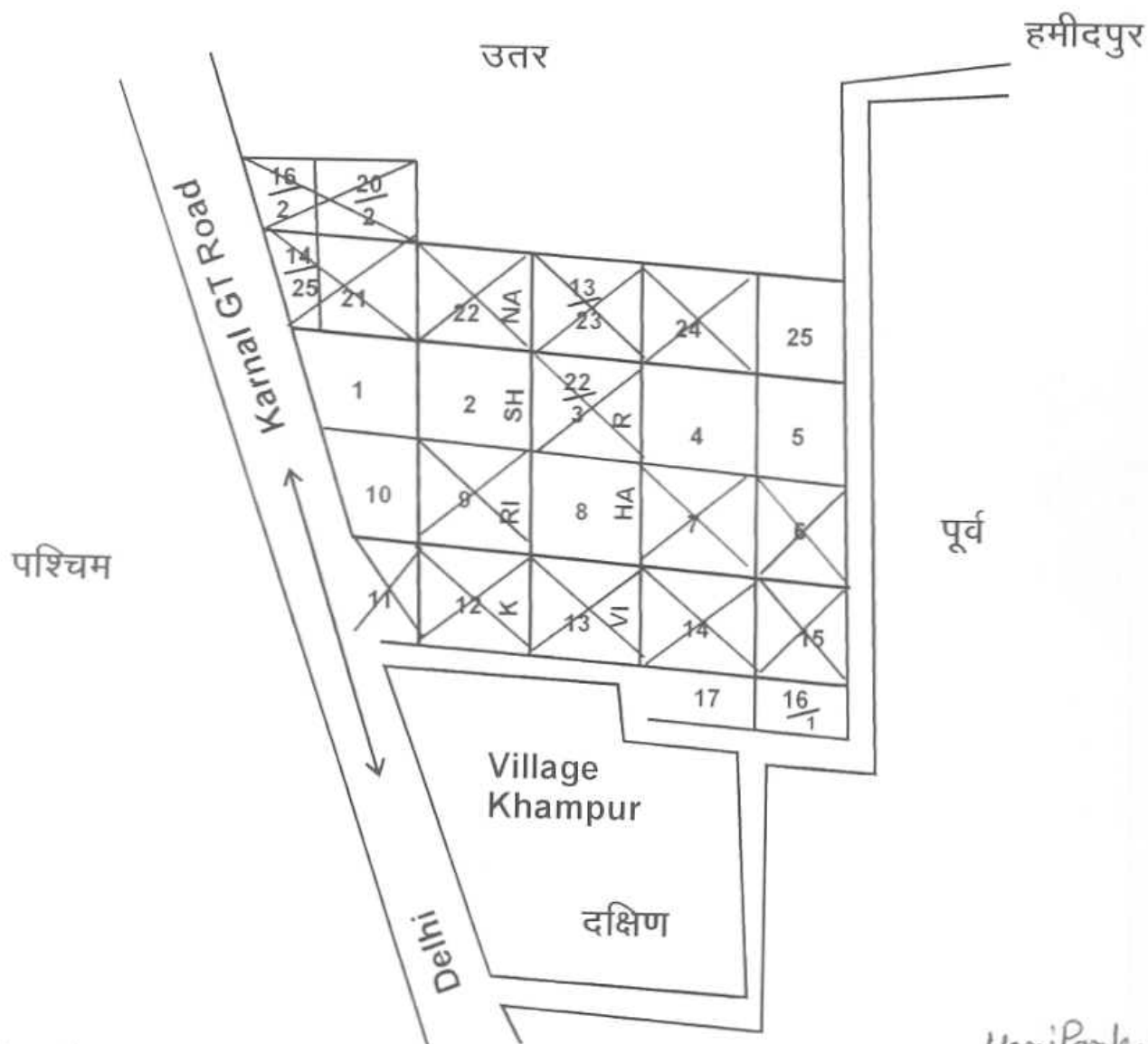

25. Liability of the Member of the Governing Body:

No member of the Governing Body or officer or the auditor employed by the Society shall be answerable member of or personally liable for any loss arising from the administration or application of funds and properties of the Society and shall be indemnified out of the funds of the Society against all liabilities incurred by him in connection with the activities of the Society unless such loss or damage is caused through any willful default or breach of trust or culpable negligence on his part.

36. Defects:

All acts bonafide done by any member, Representative or by any meetings of the General Body or Governing Body or Sub-Committee shall, notwithstanding that it be discovered afterwards that there was some defect in his/its/their appointment or that they/he or any of them are disqualified, be treated as if being such person or member has been duly appointed and qualified.

37. Contingency:

Any contingency not covered by these Rules may be decided upon by the Governing Body in such manner as it thinks fit.

38. General:

All the provisions of the Act shall be applicable to the Society.

28. **Source of Income:**

For the purpose of raising the finance and fund the Society shall receive, hold, accept, use any fees, contributions, bequests, donations, grants of moneys, gifts, assistance and/or endowments or the proceeds of from local source(s) and donor agencies in India or abroad.

29. **Income:**

The income of the Society, whensoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set out in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof will be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise as profits to the members of the Society PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall prevent payment in good faith of reasonable and proper remuneration for services rendered or reasonable interest on money lent or reasonable rent for any premises let.

30. **Annual List to be filed with Registrar:**

Once in every year on or before the fourteenth to be filed day succeeding the day on which the Annual General Meeting is held, a list shall be filed with the Registrar or Societies for the Jurisdiction of Delhi of the names, addresses and occupations of the members of the Governing Body then constituted as per Section-4 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

31. **Minutes:**

The General Secretary shall cause to be entered minutes of the General Meetings and meetings of the Governing Body and Sub-Committees in the books kept for the purpose.

32. **Law Suits:**

The Society may sue or be sued in the name of the President as per Section 6 of the Act.

33. **Alterations and Amendments:**

33.1. Whenever it shall appear to the Governing Body that it is advisable to change the name of the Society or to alter, extend or abridge the purposes or purposes for which the Society has been formed or to amalgamate the Society, either wholly or partially with any other Society, the Governing Body shall submit its proposition to the Members of the Society and shall convene a Special Meeting for the consideration thereof but no such proposition shall be carried into effect unless the procedure in Sections 12 and 12A of the Act is complied with.

33.2. The Rules and Regulations of the Society and other matters in the Memorandum not provided for in Rule 33.1 above may be amended at a General Meeting by passing a resolution by simple majority.

34. **Dissolution:**

The Society may be dissolved in accordance with Sections 13 and 14 of the Act.

22. Annual General Meeting:

22.1. The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held within six months from the close of the financial year of the Society. A notice of twenty one clear days for the holding of such meeting shall be sent by ordinary post to all the Members and Representatives at the address(es) registered with Society along with a statement of business to be transacted thereat and the time and place where such meeting is to be held. The notice period aforesaid may be waived by all the members and Representatives for the time being present in India.

22.2. At the Annual General Meeting, apart from any other business set by the Governing Body, the following business shall be transacted :

- i) consideration and adoption of balance sheet and the audited account of the Society ;
- ii) consideration and adoption of the Annual Report of the Governing Body regarding the working of the Society ;
- iii) consideration and approval of the budget for the following year;
- iv) election as per rules of the members of the Governing Body.
- v) appointment of Auditors of the Society.

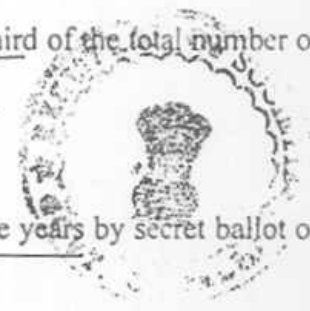


23. Quorum:

The quorum necessary for a General Meeting shall be five members or two-third of the total number of members entitled to vote, whichever is higher, present in person.

24. Election:

VILLAGE KHAMLUAR Village HA Hari Parkash
Governing Body of "~~Krishna Vihar~~ Welfare Society" will be elected after five years by secret ballot or unanimously by the members of the General Body.



25. Votes:

Each member having the right to attend and vote shall have one vote. The President or his alternate shall preside and in case of equality of votes, shall have a casting vote.

26. Audit & Bank Accounts:

The accounts of the Society shall be duly audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant, who shall be appointed by the Governing Body. The bank accounts of the Society shall be operated by at least two persons one being the Treasurer and any other person designated by the Governing Body.

27. Year:

The financial year shall, unless otherwise resolved by the Governing Body, be from 1st April to 31st March.

17. Alternates:

17.1. If any member of the Governing Body shall be likely to remain outside India for a period not less than three months, an alternate for such member of the Governing Body may be appointed by the Governing Body.

17.2. An alternate so appointed shall not hold office as such for a period longer than that permissible to the original member in whose place he has been so appointed and shall vacate office if and when the original member returns to India.

18. Power to make Byelaws:

The Governing Body may, in respect of any matters not hereby expressly provided for make such Byelaws from time to time with regard to the conduct of the business or management of the affairs of the Society as it may think proper or necessary with power to add, alter, amend, abridge, substitute, or delete any provisions of such By-laws.

19. Meetings of Governing Body

19.1. The Governing Body shall hold meetings at least four times in a year or at such earlier intervals as may be necessary and shall be convened by the President. The Governing Body may adjourn or otherwise regulate its meetings and proceedings as it may think fit.

19.2. At least 7 days notice of the time and place shall be given for a meeting of the Governing Body, but a meeting may be called at shorter notice if the members thereof for the time being in India unanimously agree to waive the aforesaid period of 7 days.

19.3. At least two members including President, Secretary or their alternates shall constitute a quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body.

19.4. The Governing Body shall take decisions by majority vote and every member shall have one vote. The President or his alternate shall preside and in case of equality of votes, shall have a casting vote.

19.5. A resolution signed by three-fourth majority of the members of the Governing Body after circulation amongst all the members shall be as effective and binding as a resolution passed by a meeting of the Governing Body.

20. Sub-Committees:

The Governing Body may select some of themselves to form Sub-Committee with such duties and powers as may be assigned and subject to such rules of procedure as may be laid down by the Governing Body.

21. General Meeting:

In addition to any other General Meetings the Society shall hold each year an Annual General Meeting of the General Body of the Society. The Secretary shall be an ex-officio member of the General Body.

- (xii) To apply to Government bodies, public bodies municipal and other authorities, corporations or other bodies or persons for, and to accept grants of money and/or moveable and/or land, buildings or donations, gifts, trusts and other assistance and/or borrow money for promoting the objects of the Society and to extend, utilise and deal with the same in or for the purpose of achieving the aims and objects of the Society;
- (xiii) To purchase, take in exchange, or on lease or hire or otherwise acquire or get any gift of or procedure any lands, buildings, or property, machinery, equipments, apparatus, or other articles or things including all moveable or immoveable properties required for the activities and purpose of the Society;
- (xiv) To make gifts, grants, donations, loans, trusts, and/or sell, transfer, lease out, manage, develop, borrow on, mortgage, encumber, pledge, dispose of or otherwise alienate or deal with all or any part of the immoveable and/or moveable properties and assets of the Society in any part or parts in India;
- (xv) To appoint, dismiss and reappoint all staff of the Society;
- (xvi) To enter into, defend and compromise litigation of all kinds;
- (xvii) To invest any monies or funds of the Society in such manner as the Governing Body may from time to time determine without any profit making purposes;
- (xviii) To establish trusts whether for the benefit of the employees of the Society or otherwise for the objects of the Society;
- (xix) To pay, settle and/or disburse expenses, fees, costs for implementing the objects of the Society;



15. Cessation of Membership of Governing Body:

The office of a member of the Governing Body shall fall vacant if a member:

- i) dies, or voluntarily resigns his office;
- ii) becomes incapacitated by reasons of illness, lunacy or insolvency or if he is indicted for an offence involving moral turpitude;
- iii) remains absent from three consecutive meetings of the Governing Body without obtaining prior leave of the President;
- iv) being a Representative, he is removed from the Governing Body by the Member which he represents or such Member ceases to be a member of the Society.

16. Filling of Vacancies in Governing Body:

In case the office of a member of the Governing Body is vacant for whatever reason, it may be filled in the by Governing Body till the next Annual General Meeting.

- f) Maximum of four other members to be elected from amongst the Members and Representatives at every Annual General Meeting.

14. Powers of Governing Body:

14.1. The management and control of the affairs of the Society shall vest in the Governing Body.

14.2. Without prejudice to the generality of the powers of the Governing Body mentioned in Rule 14.1 above, the Governing Body shall have the following powers, namely :

- (i) To establish a Centre to conduct research in human rights violations and abuses with a view to disseminating the result of the research for the benefit of the general public and the international institutions and community.
- (ii) To engage, experts, instructors and professors to impart, upto date knowledge, information and instructions in the field and subjects of the Society.
- (iii) Support and cooperate with other organisations working for the implementation of the same objects;
- (iv) To undertake research, and publication of educational material(s) on human rights;
- (v) To provide financial assistance for an infrastructure to carry out the above programmes;
- (vi) To assist and undertake studies, surveys, discussions, seminars, conferences, shows and exhibitions or topics and subjects which will help the objects of the Society being implemented;
- (vii) To espouse, establish, further and promote relationships with similar organisations or institutions of repute working in similar fields or engaged in like activities;
- (viii) To undertake projects entrusted by and/or to work in close collaboration with Government, Semi-Government, or other bodies or persons having the same objects as of the Society and/or for promoting or supporting any activities of Government, semi-government educational and/or charitable or similar institutions operating in similar fields;
- (ix) To organise, funds, promote and encourage, exhibitions, fairs, seminars, lectures, film shows etc. and to publish and distribute without any profit motive, journals, periodicals, newsletters, pamphlets, books, booklets, etc. and other modes of mass communication including audiovisual modes;
- (x) To receive, use, hold, accept and apply any fees, contributions, bequests, donations or endowment or the proceeds thereof for carrying out the objects of the Society;
- (xi) To seek recognition from Government, municipal authority or other authorities or bodies for the activities of the Society and related fields and services;

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9. President:

- 9.1. The President of the Society will be elected by a majority of votes after every five years, so long as possible from amongst the Founder Members and thereafter from the individual-voting members of the Society.
- 9.2. The President or his alternate shall normally preside at all meetings of the Governing Body and the General Body of the Society.
- 9.3. The President or his alternate shall perform and carry out and exercise all powers duties & functions as the Governing Body may assign to him from time to time and exercise all such powers, privileges and discretion and do all such acts, matters and things as may be necessary or convenient for the administration of the general policies and promoting the subjects of the Society.

10. General Secretary:

- 10.1. There shall be a Secretary of the Society who will be elected by a majority of votes after every five years.
- 10.2. The Secretary shall be the Chief Executive of the Society and shall have all powers of management of the affairs of the Society.

11. Assistant Secretary:

Assistant Secretary will enjoy all the powers of Secretary in his/her absence. Assistant Secretary will sign on behalf of the Society, conduct its correspondence and to record the proceedings of such meetings.

12. Treasurer:

- 12.1. The Treasurer of the Society will be elected by a majority of votes after every five years in the same manner as the President and Secretary.
- 12.2. The Treasurer shall be responsible for having the accounts of the Society maintained properly and he shall be a signatory in all bank accounts of the Society.

13. Governing Body

- 13.1. The Governing Body shall consist of not less than four and not more than seven members all or whom shall be individuals.
- 13.2. The Governing Body shall be constituted as under :

- President
- Vice President
- Secretary
- Assistant Secretary
- Treasurer

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4. Fees & Subscription:

The Governing Body shall have the power to prescribe such entry fees and annual subscription for Members, as it may consider fit and to waive the same or any part thereof for any members or class of members. At the time of formation of Society each member will pay Rs. 551/- and Rs. 100/- p.m.

5. Associates:

The Society may admit any person or institution as Associate Members of the Society on such terms and conditions as may be decided by the Governing Body. Associate Members shall have no voting rights.

6. Cessation of Membership

A member of the Society shall cease to be so:-

- a) by death, in capacity or insolvency in the case of individual members and on dissolution or amalgamation, in the case of others,
- b) upon the annual subscription being in arrears for more than 3 months from the date on which it is due,
- c) upon receipt by the Society of notice of resignation in writing from a member or Representative, under a registered cover,
- d) upon expulsion by the Members in General Meeting PROVIDED that before a resolution is passed, an opportunity shall be given to the Member concerned to appear and explain his position with regard to the point in issue but in the event of his non-availing the opportunity or the General Meeting not accepting the explanation, no question shall be raised with regard to the validity and effectiveness a resolution passed in the manner laid down PROVIDED FURTHER that a Founder Member shall not be liable to expulsion.

7. Emergency Membership:

In case the number of members of the Society for whatever reason falls below seven the majority of the remaining members of the General Body shall be entitled to fill up the vacancy(ies).

8. Title Deed

- 8.1. All properties, moveable or immovable of the Society shall vest in the Governing Body who shall be the trustees of the Society.
- 8.2. All deeds, agreements, leases, releases, mortgages or documents of whatever nature relating to or affecting the properties or interest of the Society shall be executed by the Secretary of the Society and failing him by such person as may be authorised by the Governing Body.

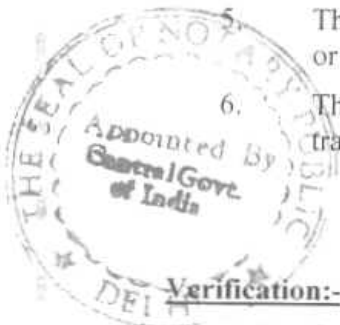
