



Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Department of Urban Development is only implementing the Policy Guidelines / Regulations issued by Govt. of India from time to time. That this Government is bound to consider only those colonies which are covered under policy and can not go beyond that. Since, Sainik Farms is inhabited by affluent section of society and is not being considered for regularization till the separate policy guidelines for these colonies are received from Govt, of India.
