### ORDER

- WHEREAS one quarter of Delhi's population resides in less than 6% of the total area of the capital in Trans Yamuna Area resulting in phenomenal density of population and haphazardous growth of unplanned building activity and proliferation of substandard areas as compared to the other areas of Delhi.
- WHEREAS immense pressure has been placed on the existing infrastructural facilities which are totally inadequate and the gap between the increasing demand for civic amenities and the actual provision of the same has been widening an compared to the other areas of Delhi.
- 3: WHEREAS the topography of Trans Yamuna area causes large areas to be water logged following even to the alightest rainfall, and natural drainage, because of absence of gradient, is a perious problem and which requires special and urgent measures as compared to the other areas of Delhi.

(v) to review the progress of the implementation of the schemes and to recommend to the Government of Delhi the quantum of financial assistance required for the execution or implementation of any project or scheme in the Area Plan, or to be included; for the subsequent financial year.

(vi) The Board shall have a Secretarial staff consisting of a Secretary and such other officers and employees as the Government of NCT of Delhi may by order determine.

Funds will be placed at the disposal of the Board for the discharge of the above mentioned functions. The Board, on examining the detailed existing plans for the area, will allocate these funds to the Department/Organisations concerned for executing specific schemes.
