- 11. Executing Agency will maintain a separate Inventory/Stock Register for items procured under MLALAD Scheme.
- 12. The funds under the MLALAD Scheme will be utilized by the agencies strictly in accordance with the existing guidelines and with the parameters of the scheme on approved item of work as amended from time to time. The executing agencies will strictly follow the provisions as per CPWD work manual.

13. The quarterly progress report (Financial and Physical) by various agencies (area wise) under MLALADS shall be intimated to Planning Department/UD Department.

14. The executing agency will be responsible for technical and financial scrutiny and approval of detailed estimate for each work.

15. The Executing agencies will also ensure that the work estimate has been checked by their planning section and approved by the Competent Authority as per Delegation of Financial Power before the execution of the works.

16. Copy of cost of Index over DSR should be provided to UD Department by Executing Agency and placed in record before the Execution of works.

17. The executing agency will observe the provisions of GFRs and work manual for execution & award of the work.

18. Similar nature of work should be treated as single project.

19.
